A. PROGRAM

B. HOUSEKEEPING

C. DRESS

1. Beach towels, robes, or appropriate covering will be worn to and from the swimming pool at all times. Dark t-shirts will be worn over two piece suits.
2. Finger-length shorts and capris are allowed to be worn for evening worship by all campers.
3. No undergarments can show under or over clothing – no midriffs showing – no halter tops – no message t-shirts featuring rock music groups, alcohol, tobacco products, or inappropriate or suggestive statements are allowed. **NO SAGGY PANTS.**
4. Shorts must be the length to the tip of fingers as the camper's arms are to their side and no shorter.

D. CONDUCT
